Contestants' suggested entry donation is \$10 for adults and \$5 for youths.

Registrations must be received by Wednesday, September 19.

Each Contestant should provide about 1.5 to 2 gallons of chili in a crock pot. Electrical service will be provided by the church. All Chili needs to be at serving temperature and at your designated position to start serving by 11:00 AM. Tasters/judges will be allowed to sample chilis until approximately 2pm. If desired, you may provide condiments to accompany your chili, such as shredded cheese, sour cream, onions, etc.

Mini cornbread muffins will be provided. Tasting cups and spoons will be provided. Pitchers of water and drink cups will be provided.

Tasting judges will vote and the Winner and Runner-up will be announced before the end of the Fair. Winners will receive a trophy, high praise, and bragging rights!
