



Five Wednesdays beginning March 8... In the Parlor




Prayer Service

7:00 - 7:30 p.m.

This half-hour worship service focuses on God's promise in Christ: That You May Have Life. The service is mostly sung (similar to the Holden Evening Prayer we did on January 1st), and includes prayers, scripture, and simple hymns.

Book Discussion (7:30 - 9:00 p.m.) The Case for Christ, by Lee Strobel

This book examines Jesus from the perspective of an investigative journalist, considering the skeptics' view and asking the hard questions about who he was and what the Bible says about him. We'll begin our time with a 15 minute teaching video and then discuss the suggested chapters for the night.


